
# Do-It-Yourself (DIY) Guide Using ENERGY STAR® Product Finder

#### What is ENERGY STAR® Certification?


ENERGY STAR® is the industry standard certification for energy efficient appliances. Georgia's Home Energy Rebates uses the ENERGY STAR® certification to determine whether the selected electric appliance is eligible for a rebate.

#### Using the ENERGY STAR® Product Finder

- 1. Open your preferred browser, e.g., Chrome, Safari, Microsoft Edge.
- 2. Go to energystar.gov/productfinder.
- 3. From the ENERGY STAR® Product Finder, navigate to "Appliances." Under Appliances, click on Residential Electric Cooking Products.




4. On the ENERGY STAR® Electric Cooking Products webpage, there is a list of all the ENERGY STAR® certified cooktops and ranges. The "Filter Your Results" section on the left side has many categories to refine your search.




#### Finding your Electric Stove, Cooktop or Range

5. To verify that your selected electric cooking product is ENERGY STAR® certified, you will need the brand name and the model number. In the Filter Your Results sidebar, scroll down to locate the Brand Name section. Select the brand name of your electric cooking product. <a href="If">If</a> you cannot find the brand name of your electric cooking product, it is not ENERGY STAR® certified.



6. After selecting for the Brand Name, the ENERGY STAR® website will reload and only show a list of ENERGY STAR® certified cooking product models with that brand name. Use this list and your selected appliance's model number to see if it is ENEGY STAR® certified. Please note that the asterisk (\*) in the model number indicates that digit can be any alphabetical letter and still be covered by the same ENERGY STAR® certification.




For example, JB256**DMCC** is a model number that is covered under the ENERGY STAR® certification for JB256\***M**\*\*\*.

#### **Helpful Information**

If you cannot match your electric cooking product model number to any of the listed products, your electric cooking product is not ENERGY STAR® certified and will not qualify for Georgia's Home Energy Rebates. However, you can use the ENERGY STAR® Product Finder to choose a new electric cooking product that is ENERGY STAR® certified.

### **Comparing Multiple Products**


 The ENERGY STAR® Product Finder has a feature that allows you to compare 2-4 products and their key characteristics at the same time. To use this feature, browse the ENERGY STAR® Product Finder website and click the compare checkbox for models you are interested.



2. After selecting your 2-4 products, there will be a section at the top of the list with all the model numbers you have selected. To remove a model, hit the X at the top right corner of the grey box with the model number.



3. Once you are ready to compare your electric cooking products, hit the orange compare button. This will open a new webpage with a chart of the products you selected to easily compare characteristics like dimensions, annual energy consumption, and other features.
