

GEORGIA'S HOME ENERGY REBATES GEOTAGGING PHOTOS GUIDE

Geotagging on mobile devices stores the location where a photo was taken as part of the photo file data. The process is different depending on if you are an iPhone or Android user. Both options are illustrated below. If your phone's model is not covered, call Georgia's Home Energy Rebates call center for troubleshooting.

Tips for your application:

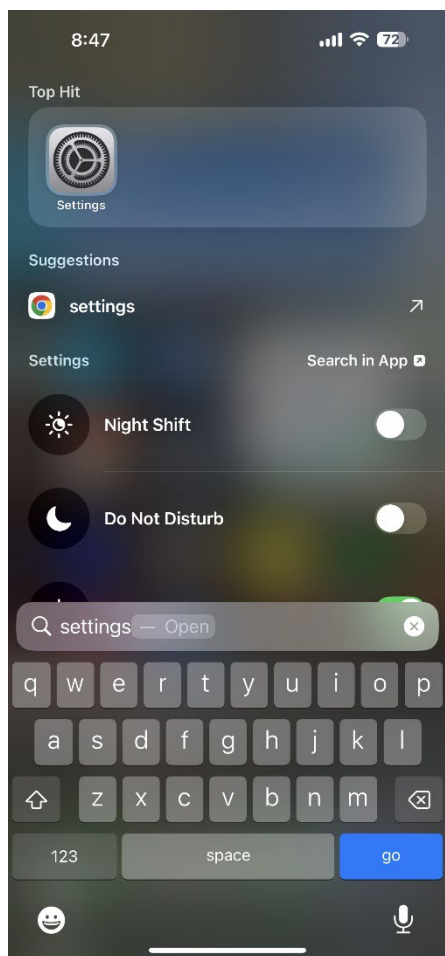
- Always ensure photos attached to the application contain a geotag.
- When attaching geotagged photos to an application, do not attach as a ZIP file.

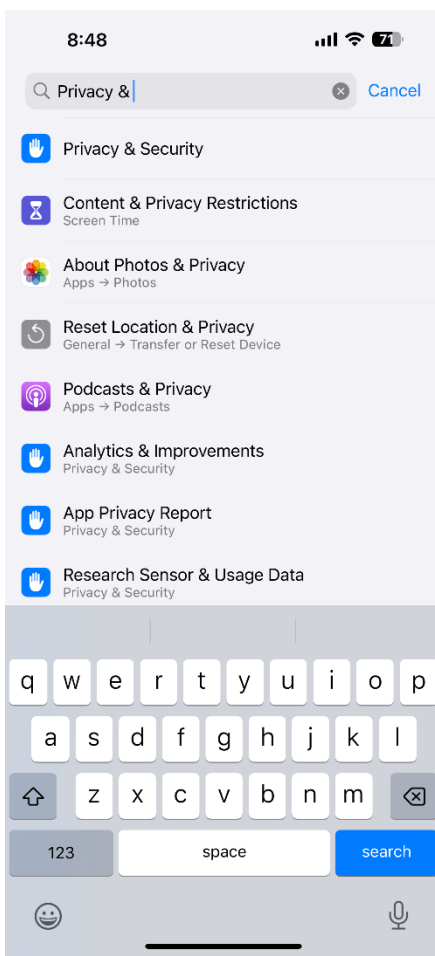
Activating Location Services

4. Check if Location Services is turn on.

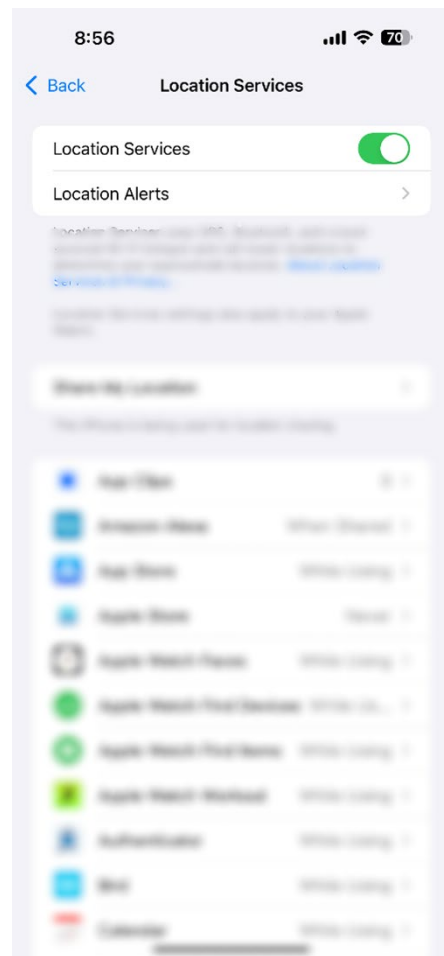

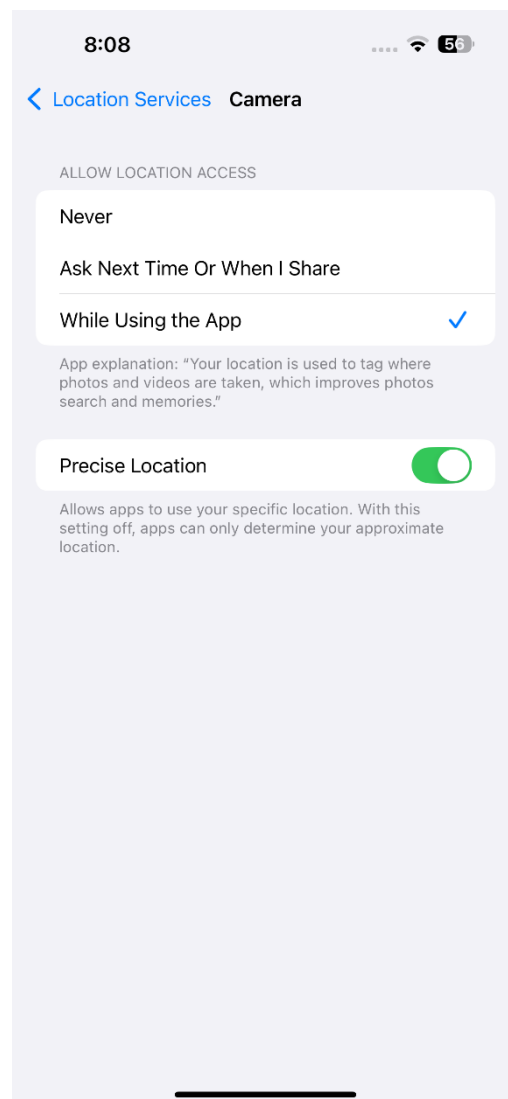
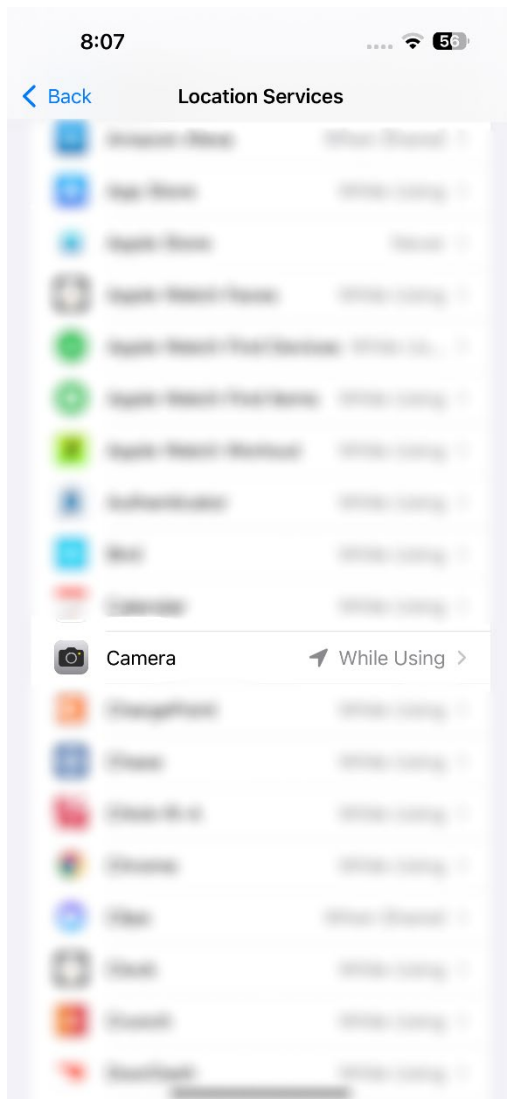

Activating Location Services for the Camera:

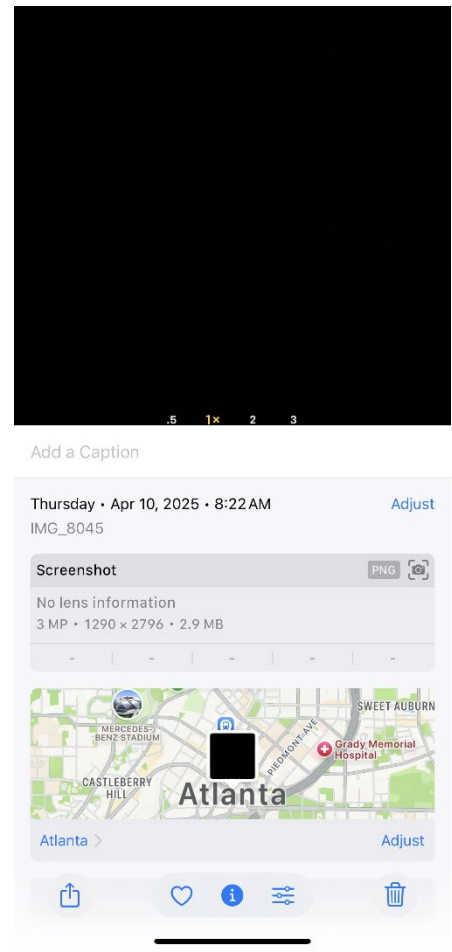
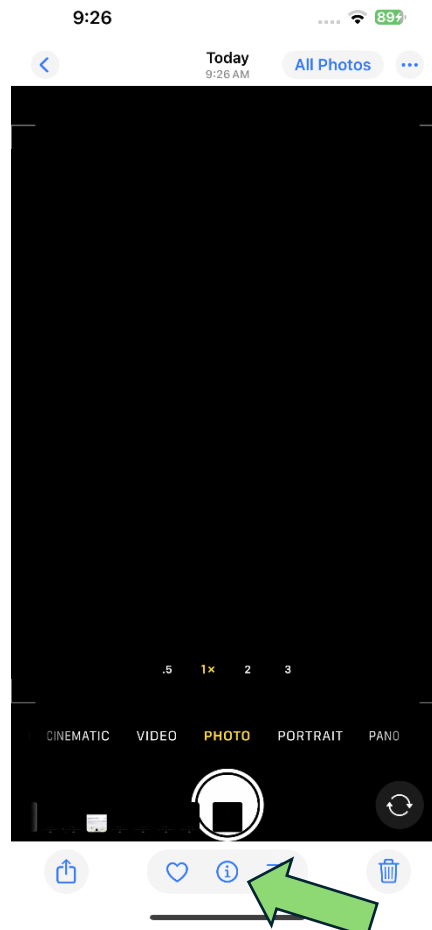
5. Scroll to Camera under the Location Services tab.

Testing Location Services:

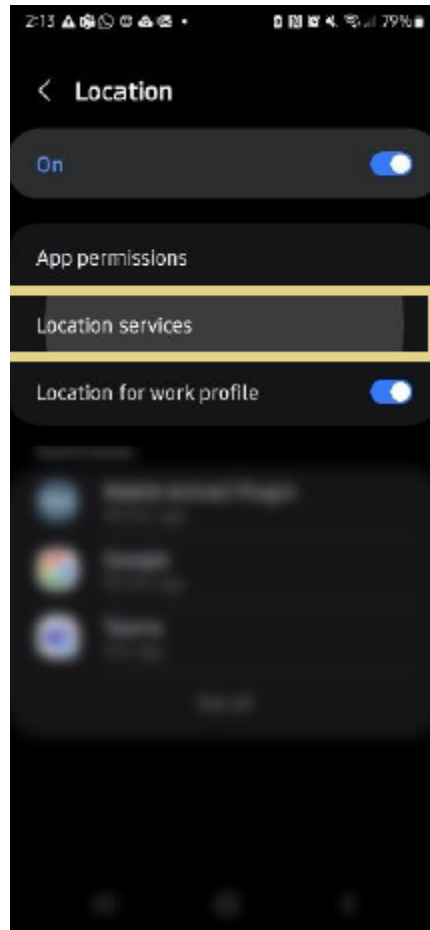
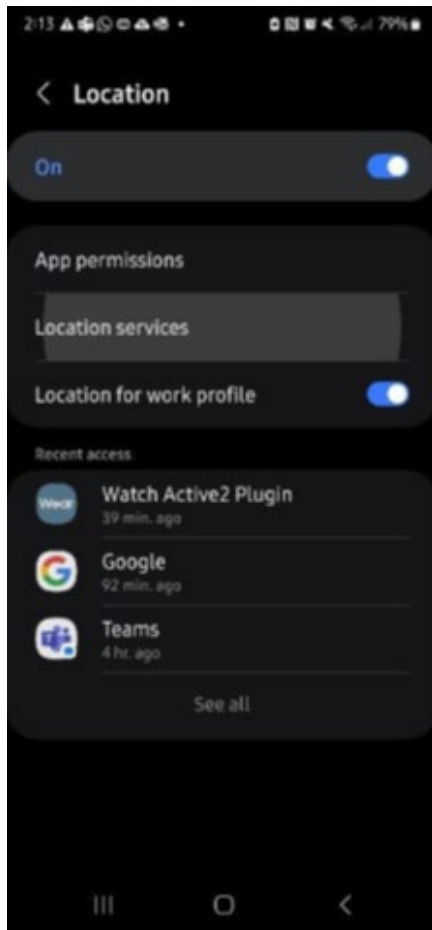
1. Open your camera and take a photo.

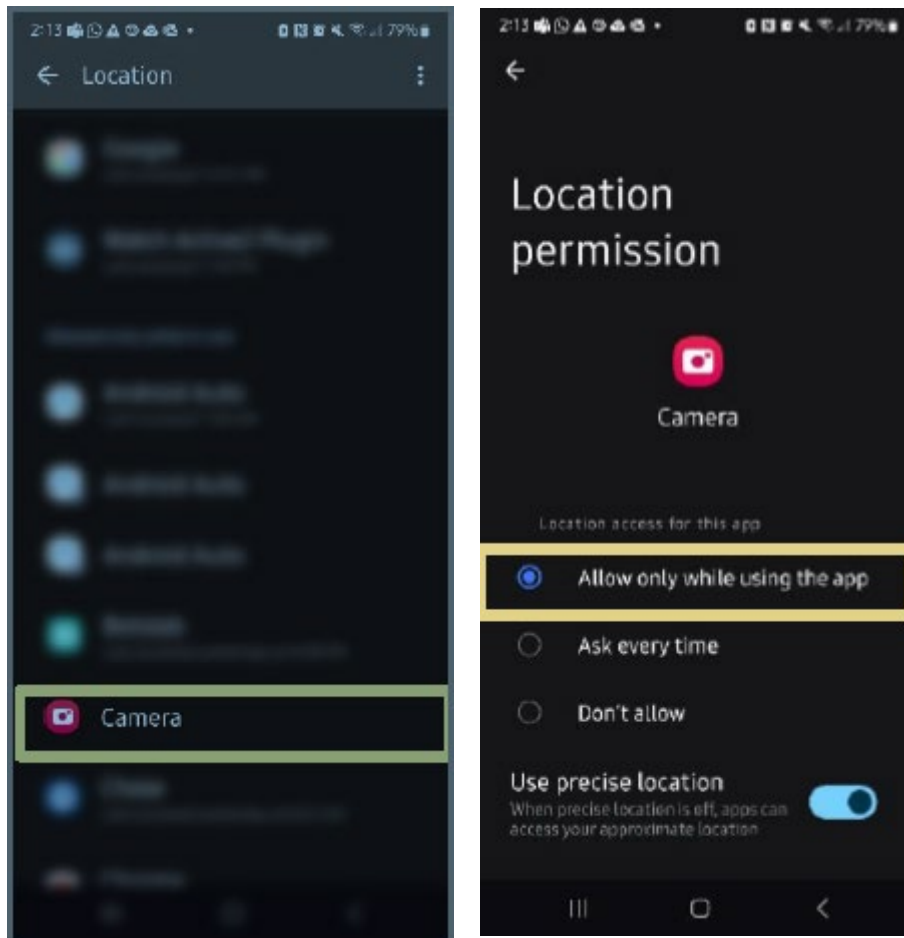
1. In your Setting's App search bar, search for and click "Location."
